Dear Mr. Lombardy,

I wanted to inform you that your inquiry to EC Council to work with the IISFA regarding a scholarship program has been reviewed and accepted.

The consideration for this award was due to the fact that IISFA lost its Founding leader in an unfortunate accident that sent the organization into a "tail spin." EC Council has reviewed your organization and believes that working together with IISFA to help its members gain an industry recognized certification would be beneficial to IISFA and its individual members, as well as the Computer Forensics Industry.

As you know the field of Computer Forensics is a rapidly growing segment of the IT Security industry and courses like EC Council's Certified Ethical Hacker and Computer Hacking Forensic Investigator have been catalysts for that growth.

EC Council recognizes that many of your members have already paid for the CIFI training and examination that was offered through the IISFA, and that many of these members didn't ever receive their certification.

EC Council would like to offer a \$1280 scholarship to each of the IISFA members, The scholarship would available to be utilized toward the tuition required to attend EC Council's Computer Hacking Forensic Investigator (C|HFI) certification program via EC Council's direct training program; iClass. iClass is a live, online, instructor-led training modality.

The CHFI course runs in two formats so that students can attend a course that is best suited for their schedule.

1. FlexClass: Twice a week for 5 weeks from 4pm to 8pm MST.
2. iWeek: Every day for 5 consecutive days from 8am to 4pm MST.

The SRP of the course is \$2895 and includes the courseware, shipping and certification exam voucher to sit for the exam at either a Prometric or VUE testing center.

The Scholarship we are offering was orchestrated with two specific factors in mind. The first was the health of the IISFA, while the second was the cost to the member in this tough economic time.

\$ 1,280.00 EC Council Scholarship
\$ 1,615.00 Member Price

As you can see from the table above, the member pays \$1615 which is a huge savings off MSRP! This rate will include courseware, shipping the courseware to the member, and the certification exam voucher.

IISFA Scholarship Enrollment Process Adendum

Hello IISFA member, please follow the following process when signing up for the scholarship EC Council has agreed to grant to the members of the IISFA:

1. Email your interest to participate in said scholarship to me at eric.lopez@eccouncil.org . and which dates appeal most to you.
2. I will then send you a "Student Enrollment" form, and inform you of enrollment availability.
3. Please fill it out completely and email it back with the dates that interest you most.
4. Once I receive your Student Enrollment form, I will send you an invoice via Google's Secure Checkout.

EC Council utilizes Google's secure checkout platform for credit card payments; this helps us keep compliant with PCI standards. Here is the process:

1. I will send an invoice to you that will come directly from Google. Watch that it doesn't get caught in your Spam Blocker. Click on the link in the email and you will be redirected to Google's Secure Checkout platform.
2. If you receive an error (which happens occasionally), just copy the link and paste it in your browser window, because sometimes clicking the link doesn't put the whole address into the browser window. (Not sure why.)
3. You will be asked to create a login and once logged in; you will be given the invoice.
4. Enter your credit card info to this secure checkout platform. (You will receive an email receipt.)
5. I will be notified that a payment was made.
6. I will contact you to confirm that I received payment
7. I will also confirm your enrollment and ship your courseware immediately!

48 hours prior to your class start time, you will be sent an invite to the online session and the class will go live on the time scheduled! On the last day of class, I will send you a Post Event Survey for your feedback and I will also send you your exam voucher. (Be sure to fill in which provider you prefer where applicable on your Student Enrollment form.)
